
Project Components Facts sheet: Barbados

Caribbean Small Island Developing States (SIDS) Multicountry Soil Management Initiative for Integrated Landscape Restoration and Sustainable Food Systems: Phase 1 (CSIDS-SOILCARE Phase 1) PISLM CSIDS-SOILCARE Project.

Component 2 Intervention Sites

Barbados has seven (7) intervention sites. Sedge Pond, Greenland Over Hill, and Coggins Estate fall under component 2 of the project. This component focuses on: "Addressing the drivers of land degradation through the rehabilitation of land and soil degraded areas; the promotion of integrated landscape management and and identification restoration the and implementation of livelihood alternatives for communities". The main land degradation issues are soil erosion and climate variability, particularly extended dry periods with higher temperatures.





Component 3 Intervention Site

Nature Fun Ranch is the selected intervention site under this component which looks at "Resilience Building to Land Degradation. Natural **Disasters** Climate Change through Climate Smart Agriculture and Drought Risk Management". This intervention site is characterized by intense ranching activities which causes soil erosion and has degraded the land.

Component 4 Intervention Site

This component focuses on the "Enhancement of Food Systems and Alternative Livelihoods through promoting agricultural and livestock production systems innovations and mobilization of the Private Sector in Support of LDN Special Climate Change Fund (SCCF)". The areas selected for intervention of this component are Misty Woods Farm, Mystic Valley Farm, and Codrington College. The land degradation issues in these areas include biological deterioration, decline in soil fertility/biodiversity and vegetation reduction.
