Component 4 Intervention Sites

Belize has two (2) intervention sites. The selected sites Patchakan and Libertad fall under component 4 of the project. This component focuses on the "Enhancement of Food Systems and Alternative Livelihoods through promoting agricultural and livestock production systems innovations and mobilization of the Private Sector in Support of LDN Special Climate Change Fund (SCCF)".





Patchakan Intervention Site

Patchakan is a small dispersed settlement engaged mainly in agricultural activities such as sugarcane farming, grains, vegetables, and livestock production. This area's main land degradation challenges are biological deterioration, water availability, decline in soil biodiversity, soil erosion and loss, vegetation reduction, and water contamination.

Libertad Intervention Site

Libertad is the second intervention site. The area comprises a small dispersed settlement. The land is mainly used for sugar cane production and residential purposes; fishing is done during the rainy season. Soil and water contamination and vegetative reduction are the main land degradation types.
